

Abstract Submission Guidelines November 2021

- Abstract content must meet the standard of an academic / scientific presentation.
- In cases of research or clinical study, the abstract must be based on the original research or original clinical case studies, or their modifications.
- The AEEDC Scientific Organising Committee will evaluate the content of each abstract and make the final selection of the abstracts for presentation.
- The presentation must cover the same material as the abstract.
- If the abstract has been selected for presentation the speaker automatically gives permission for the abstract published in the conference program or to any post-conference announcement.
- No abstracts will be considered after **20 February 2021**
- For any withdrawals, the speaker should notify the *organiser in writing as soon as possible or minimum of 2 months prior to the event.
- For any accepted abstract, power point presentation should be submitted within 3 weeks from the date of the acceptance email. delay in submission the presentation will result in delay on CPD accreditation and possibly in cancellation the session.
- Any particular equipment and materials which is necessarily to conduct the session is be declared to organiser and approved to be obtained latest by the submission of the presentation.

- Projection Screen Ratio: 3:1 or 1920x640 Pixels;
- Screen Size 9 x 3 meter
- LCD Projector – 15000 ANSI LUMENS
- Laptop
- DVD player (in case of movies)
- Audio System and Speakers
- Podium Microphones | Headset Microphone or Lapel Microphone
- Laser pointer | Clicker remote
