



POSTER PRESENTATIONS & COMPETITION

The AEEDC Dubai Poster Presentation Competition offers a global stage for dental students, interns, researchers, and professionals to present original research and innovative ideas. It's your opportunity to gain international recognition, sharpen your presentation skills, and connect with leading experts who are shaping the future of dentistry.

- **How to join:**
 - The Poster Competition now has 3 categories: Main, Ortho, and OMFS.
 - Make sure to submit your Poster to the right category.
 - Conference registration is mandatory prior to poster submission.
 - If you choose the Ortho poster category, you must first register for the Ortho Conference. The same applies to the Main and OMFS categories.
 - Posters that do not fall under Ortho or OMFS should be submitted to the Main category.

Poster Sub-Categories Guidelines

1. Poster Competition (Poster Judges List)

- **What it is:**

The best of the best is hand-picked by our judges.
They will be informed and invited to present their Posters in front of the judges.
- **Prizes:**
 - Main category: 4 winners
 - Ortho + OMFS categories: 3 winners (Prizes will be announced shortly)

2. Poster Display

- **What it is:** A non-competitive way to **showcase your work** to peers.
- No judging or scoring.
- Your poster will be displayed digitally for one hour each day of **3-Day event**.
- Your presence is not mandatory. The setup is intended for attendees to view and read

the poster independently.

3. Case Report

- **What it is:** Focuses on **case study content** in your poster.
- No judging or scoring.
- Your poster will be displayed digitally for one hour each day of **3-Day event**.
- Your presence is not mandatory. The setup is intended for attendees to view and read the poster independently.

4. Second Draft Posters

- **Your submission needs fixes:**
 - You'll be asked to submit a revised version.
 - **Note:** Resubmission doesn't guarantee acceptance.

AEEDC Dubai 2027 Poster Submission Guidelines

1. Digital Posters Only

- **No paper posters** will be accepted.
- Posters must be **digital** and will be displayed vertically on **50" TV screens**
- Posters display timing slots will rotate during the 3 days of the event.

2. Registration Before Submission

- You **must register** for the **AEEDC Dubai Conference 2027** before submitting your Poster Abstract.
- **No poster will be considered** if you haven't registered.
- No extra fee is required to submit a poster.

3. Acceptance/Rejection Notification

- You'll receive an email (acceptance or rejection) **within 2-3 weeks** after the **deadline: November 30, 2026**.

4. Original Work Required

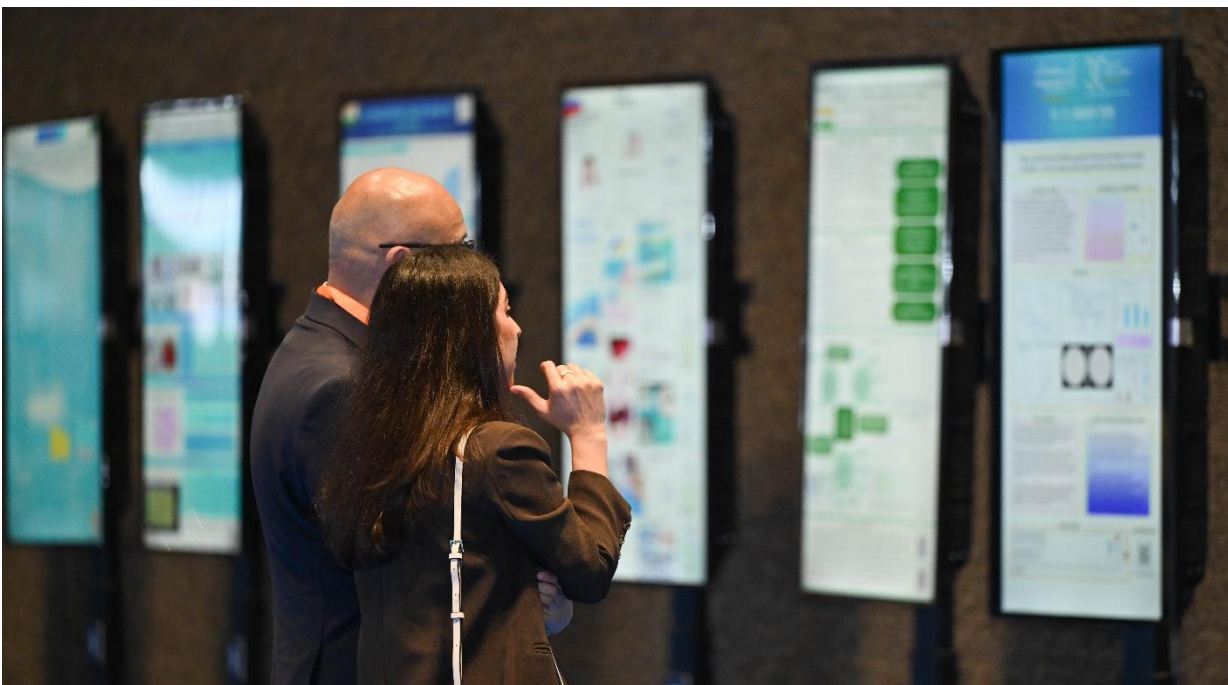
- Your abstract must be based on original research or original clinical case studies.

5. Evaluation Process

- The **AEEDC Poster Judges** will review all abstracts and decide which ones are accepted to which sub-category. Their decisions are finals.

6. Strict Deadline

- **No late submissions** will be accepted after **November 30, 2026**.



7. Withdrawal Policy

- If you need to withdraw, you must email the organizers at least 2 months before the event.
- No refunds for conference registrations.

8. Author & Institution Formatting

- Author name & degrees: ALL CAPS (e.g., JOHN SMITH, DDS*).
- Presenter's name: HESSA with an asterisk (*).
- Institution name: Inside (parentheses).

9. Authors & Affiliations

- List all authors and their institutions **below the title** in a **smaller font size**.

10. Abstract Structure

- Your Poster must follow the **scientific format below**:
 - ✓ Introduction
 - ✓ Objectives
 - ✓ Materials & Methods
 - ✓ Results (including data & stats, if applicable)
 - ✓ Conclusions

11. Poster Updates After Acceptance

- If you need to make changes, send the **revised digital poster** within **2 weeks** of acceptance.
- Reply to the **acceptance email** with your updated file.

12. Acceptance Not Guaranteed

- Conference registration does not mean your poster will be accepted automatically.
- No refunds if your poster is rejected.



Digital Poster Format Guidelines

1. Poster Orientation

- **Must be VERTICAL** (like a traditional paper poster, see below 2 examples).

2. Resolution & Size

- **Dimensions: 3840 pixels (Height) × 2160 pixels (Width).**
- **File size: Max 5MB** (keep it high-quality but not oversized).

3. File Formats

- **Required: .JPG** for TV display.

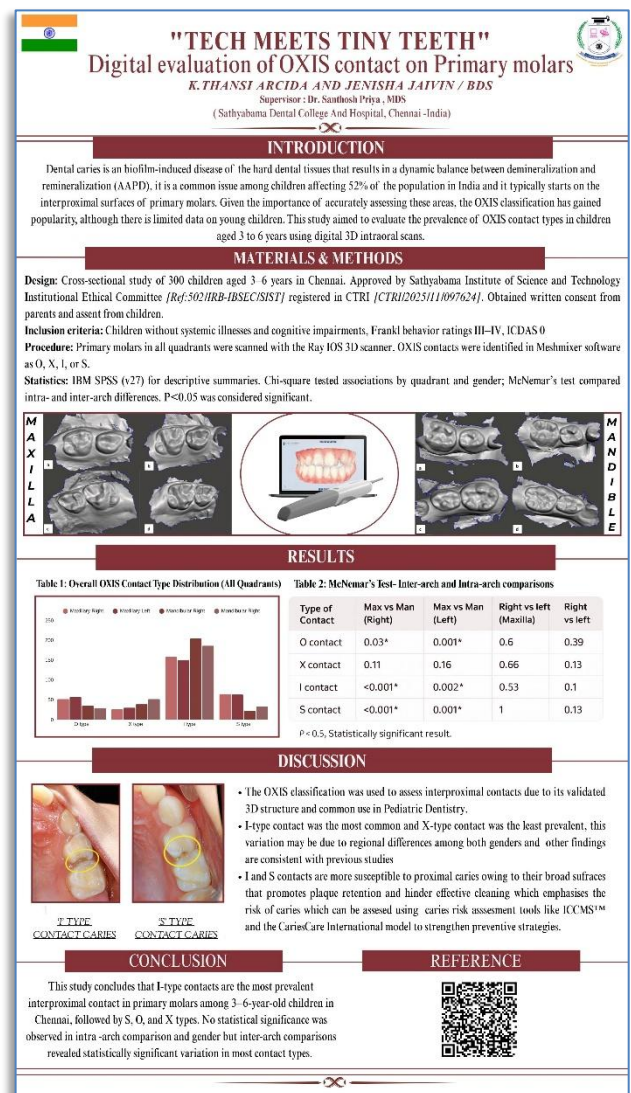
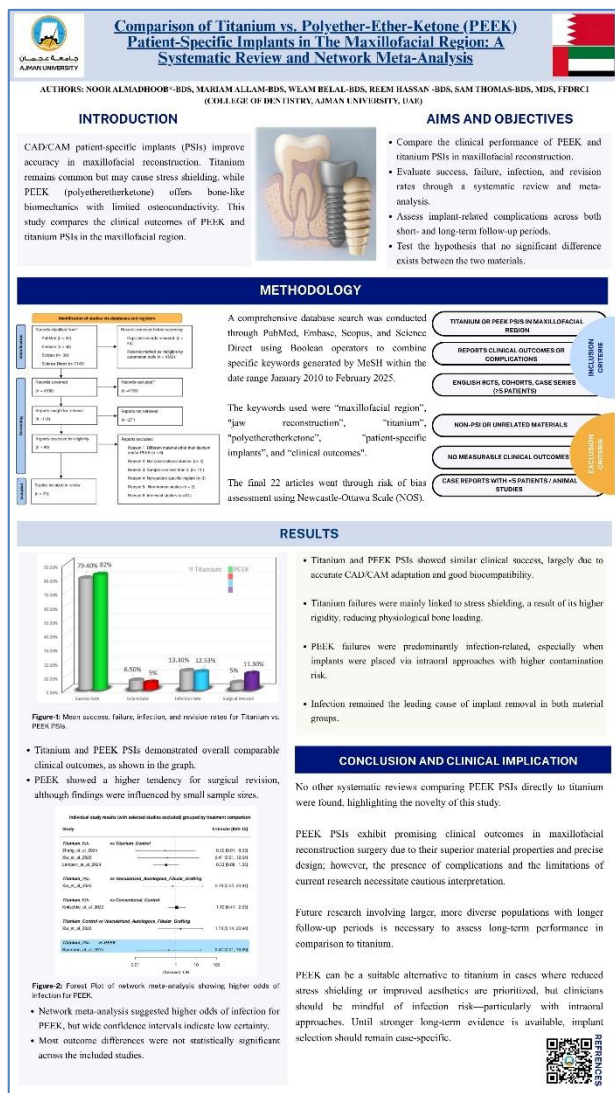
4. Font Size (Readability Matters!)

- **Minimum font size: 25pt** (so text is easy-to-read on screen).

5. Country Flag Requirement

- **Must include your country's flag** (represent where you're from).

General Poster Guidelines

Abstract Review Process

- The **Scientific Review Board** will evaluate all submitted abstracts.
- Participants will be placed into **one of three sub-categories**:
 - **Poster Competition (*ONLY category to be considered for the prizes*)**
 - **Poster Display (No prizes)**
 - **Case Report (No prizes)**

(In 2026, only 24 posters were chosen for the Competition from 400+ posters)

Poster Competition Details

- **Presentation Format:**
 - **7-minute on-stage PowerPoint Presentation** followed by **3-minute Q&A** with the Scientific Review Panel.
 - **Date: 20th January 2027**



Poster Competition Presentation – AEEDC Dubai 2026

- **Schedule:**
 - Will be emailed to presenters and posted online.
 - Includes **Poster number, Screen number, and Display times** (for all 3 days).
- **Presenter Rules:**
 - Max **2 presenters** per poster.
 - **Mandatory in-person attendance on 20th January 2027** (confirmed via email after acceptance).
- **Judging & Awards:**

- **4 winners** will be selected and announced at the **AEEDC Awarding Ceremony (21st January 2027)**. Cash prizes will be given to winners during the ceremony. Winners' Names and Photos will be shown on AEEDC Dubai website.

Certificates & Recognition

- **Registered Authors/Co-Authors:** Receive a **Certificate of Appreciation**.
- **Non-Registered Supervisors:** Can request a **To-whom-it-may-concern Letter**.

Poster Display Schedule

- Will be emailed and published on aeedc.com website, showing:
 - **TV / Screen number**
 - **Display times** (across 3 days).

How to submit your Poster (Easy 5-Step Guide)

Step 1: Register for the Conference

- You must complete your **AEEDC Dubai 2027 conference registration** before submitting. You are required to enter your valid, paid, CONFERENCE registration number to accept your poster submission.

Step 2: Create Your Abstract Portal Account

- Visit the [Abstract Portal](#).
- Click "[Create an Account](#)" and fill out your profile.
- You'll land on your **Dashboard** afterward.

Step 3: Start Your Submission

- From the top menu, select "**Submissions**" → "**Create new submission**".
- Choose "**Poster Presentation**".

Important: Only **1 submission per author** is allowed!

Step 4: Upload Your Materials

Submit these **3 required items**:

1. Your **Poster Abstract**
2. Your **Conference Registration Number**
3. Your **Poster File (.JPG format)**

(Check the General Poster Guidelines above for size/format requirements)

Step 5: Wait for Your Results

- We'll email you about your submission status 2-3 weeks after the deadline
- Check your inbox (and spam folder) regularly.

Authors & Co-Authors

- The author who submitted the poster will be considered as the **Primary Author**.
- A maximum of 3 co-authors is allowed for one poster submission.
- Names of the co-authors must be added to the Abstract Portal before the deadline.

Adding Co-Authors:

Want your team credited? Follow these simple steps:

- 1** **Log in** to your Abstract Portal account.
- 2** Go to "**Submissions**" → Select your abstract → Click the "**Authors**" tab.
- 3** From the left menu, click "**Add New Author**".
- 4** Fill in their details and **send the invitation**.

How to Get Your Poster Certificate

1. The Processing Period (3–4 Weeks)

Please allow 3-4 weeks after conclusion of the event to finalize processing the data and start sending out the Poster Certificates for the primary authors.

2. Primary Author Action

Once they receive theirs, the Primary Author must email us the details of their co-authors. We need:

(No certificates will be issued for Trade Visitors registrations)

3. The Delivery Order

- First: We send certificates to all Primary Authors.
- Second: We begin processing the Co-author certificates.

4. Co-Authors and Supervisors

Co-authors will receive their certificates 1–2 weeks after the Primary Author has submitted their details. Supervisors will get “To Whom It May Concern” Letters.
